Formulation development and Pharmaceutical Instrument handling (100 hrs)

1. Blender- Granulation- 6hrs

- a. Prepare and evaluate the blend uniformity of a highly potent and low potent drug at verifying instrument parameters using, V cone blender, Cube mixer.
- 2. Density apparatus- 6 hrs
 - a. Various USP methods and procedures for Density determination. Determine the density of a bulk powder and report the difference in Derived properties using various USP methods. Study the rationale behind selection of USP method.
- 3. Tablet Punching machine 24 hrs
 - a. Development of IR tablet by direct compression/ Setting the machine Adjusting the product parameters
- 4. Tablet coating machine- 21 hrs
 - a. Film coating of tablets, Study of effect of process variables like Role of temperature, RPM, Spray rate, on quality of Coating

- 5. Disintegration Test apparatus- 3 hrs
- 6. Dissolution Apparatus- 18hrs
 - a. Evaluation of dissolution of a tablet dosage form based on pharmacopoeial procedure and study the difference in selection of USP I and II apparatus, RPM, Height of the basket or Paddle, Temperature, Media etc.
- 7. Brookfield Apparatus- 6 hrs
 - a. Measurement of viscosity of a sample using Brookfield viscometer selection of spindle, and RPM
- 8. Rotary Evaporator-6 hrs
 - a. Preparation of crude sample by Evaporation
- 9. Cooling centrifuge-6 hrs
 - a. Separate the plasma from blood samples Working, Precautions in performing, setting of the instrument parameters. Analyse the difference in plasma separation at various RPM and time
- 10. Capsule filling machine-3 hrs
 - a. Instrument setting and filling of capsules. Density and occupancy calculation
