#### **Guest Talk**



In conclusion, participants raised questions with a view to strengthen their career goals and the speaker responded sufficiently. The overall session discussion benefitted the students.








### **CIVIL SERVICES ORIENTATION FOR PHARMACY GRADUATES.**






### **IMPORTANCE OF ANTENATAL CARE**


