Travel Expenses for national and international presentations: One per faculty once in two years is considered for reward system. Newly joined faculty, who completed probation period successfully are considered as regular faculty.

*** SEED GRANT: Grants sanctioned against the call for proposal
Principal investigator and Co-PI are mandatory in SEED grant scheme
PI and Co-PI are solely responsible for the completion of project
For 2.0lakh seed grant: PI can apply once in three years
If the PI/Co-PI leaves the institution before completing the project, he/she should inform that, well in advance and substitute suitable faculty, with the consent of research team members, who is willing to complete the project within the stipulated period.

Note: Interdepartmental research proposals are highly appreciated and considered

- Grant is only for faculty projectproposals; Student projects are not entertained under the scheme.
- The outcome expected from the SEED grantincludes the publication of minimum two research work in SCOPUS indexed journal/attainment of Patent for the submitted research.
