Seminar on "Career prospects after Pharm.D"

On February 10th 2023, an event was conducted in our college, Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Muvattupuzha regarding the Hospital Acquired Infections and career growth for PharmD graduates for the 4th year and 6th year PharmD students.

The session was conducted by Dr. Aleena Isaac, Clinical Pharmacist, Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur and Ms. Junia George, Associate Professor, Nirmala College of Pharmacy.

Dr. Aleena Isaac, had conveyed about the prevalence, causes and possible measures to eradicate such infections. Infections such as pneumonia, UTI, infection of surgical incisions, skin infections and blood infections and the symptoms that can be seen such as cough, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, headache, fever etc. Storage of certain medicines such as storage of opened propofol vial, about mercury spill, insulin sliding scale etc.

She mentioned about different type of infection such as CAUTI, CLABSI, MRSA etc. also about drug combination such as inj. Meropenm + inj. Clindamycin. and also, about treatment options for various species of organism.

She further noticed on various type of antibiotic usage and different mode of resistance pattern. She also said about how she developed an antibiogram for a government hospital and the importance of antibiogram.

How it helps to guide the clinician and pharmacist in selecting the best empiric antimicrobial treatment in the event of pending microbiology culture and susceptibility results. They are also useful tools for detecting and monitoring trends in antimicrobial resistance.

She also provided an insight on how PharmD students can also contribute to the enhancement of quality of life through hospitals. She,

mentioned on the role of clinical pharmacist in providing evidencebased information and advice about the safe and effective use of medications. Recognizing untreated health conditions that could be managed with medication therapy. Monitoring patient progress with medications and making relevant recommendations to change.

She mentioned about how to keep a rapport with the nurses and how they can help us and what to study from there clinical status.

Further, she talked about the struggles she had to go through after the studies and her career growth, to the position where she is now. She also said about her work experience in Mary Queens Mission Hospital, Kanjirappally such as providing a whatsapp DIC for all the patients and laymen of the locality and enrolment in AIMS, Thrissur.

Next session was with Ms. Junia George. She said about the roles and duties she had to do in the phamacovigilence and research department in IQVIA, Kochi.

She said about the role of a CRO (Contract Research Organization). Such as the services they can provide in biopharmaceutical development, biological assay development, commercialization, clinical development, clinical trials management, pharmacovigilance, outcomes research, and Real-world evidence.

She also said about the 4 stages of pharmacovigilance process and anlaysing i.e.,

- 1. Detection: Collection of Individual Case Safety Report (ICSRs)
- 2. Assessment
- 3. Understanding and
- 4. Prevention of adverse effects

And she said about reporting of pharmacovigilance-related data which

can be found in various sources, including patient reports, adverse

event reports, product information sheets, clinical study reports and

epidemiological studies.

The speakers answered all the questions asked by the students from

both the batches and it was indeed an add on to the information hub.


