



# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

#### PURPOSE OF MOU

### Clause 1 CO-OPERATION

# Clause 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.3 The First party will help to connect with industries or various sectors of community including business, local administrations and NGO'S
- 2.4 The first Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
- 2.5 The first Party will actively engage to help with the delivery of the training and placement of students into internships/jobs

### Clause 3 VALIDITY

- 3.1 The validity of the agreement is 3 years from the date of the agreement.
- 3.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 3.3 However, if the initiatives suggested by the second party are not in the interest or the core business activities of the first party, the first party has the liberty to refuse or reject any of the Initiatives suggested by the second party at any point in time without assigning any reason.
